2011 ANNUAL WAGE SCALE

SURVEY RESULTS

The Area 1 Limited Energy JATC MA 1099 conducted a wage survey of all its registered training agents for Limited Energy Class A and Class B Technicians to determine the average journey worker wage. The wage was calculated by adding all the reported average hourly wages and dividing the total by the number of participating training agents. In order for the wage scale to change the result needs to be at least a nickel difference and then the committee will round to the nearest nickel to determine the annual journey worker wage.

APPRENTICE WAGE REQUIREMENT

Approved training agents are **required** to pay the apprentice a minimum wage according to their period on the average journeyman wage scale as established by this committee and approved by the Director of Apprenticeship of the Bureau of Labor and Industries. (See ORS 660.142)

**INDIRECT SUPERVISION CARD
FOR CLASS A TECHNICIANS IS BACK**
EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2011

IEC was successful during the special legislative session last year in passing a limited energy Class A Indirect Supervision card that will go into effect April 1, 2011. The general rule for this card is that the apprentices can work on a job no more than 8 hours in duration by themselves. This should allow limited energy contractors some additional flexibility by putting late-term apprentices in short-term service jobs or installations by themselves.

To qualify, apprentices must have a minimum of 5000 OJT hours and have completed 7 classes in our program to be placed in last period in the program.

PAY PERIODS AND THE LAW

Regardless of when your company gets paid for a job, it is the responsibility of the employer to establish and post (along with your labor law posters) regular paydays, and checks (or direct deposits) must be available on that day. There is no excuse for paying an employee erratically, and you can be fined quite heavily for this. Oregon law also states that you be paid no LESS frequently than every 35 days.
