How Much Can I Earn?

THE AVERAGE JOURNEYMAN WAGE IS \$28.29
APPRENTICES EARN \$11.32 PER HOUR TO START.
THERE ARE TWO PAYRAISE OPPORTUNITIES A YEAR. THE PROGRAM IS A FOUR YEAR PROGRAM.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

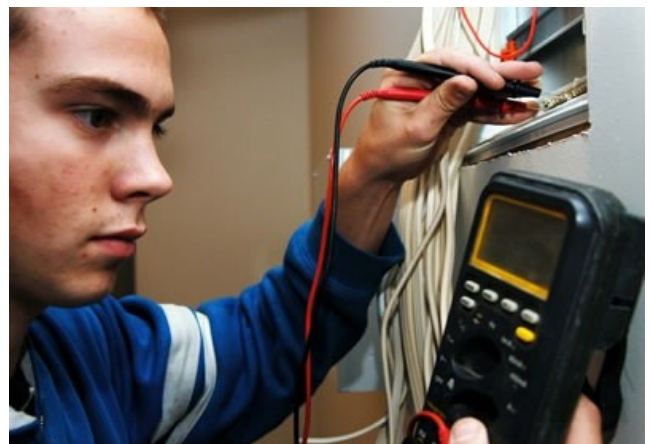
- * MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE
- * HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED CERTIFICATE
- * ONE FULL YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL ALGEBRA OR EQUIVALENT WITH A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER, OR ONE POST HIGH SCHOOL ALGEBRA COURSE WITH A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER.
- * DOCUMENTATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL ALGEBRA MUST BE TRANSCRIPT(S) IN AN OFFICIALLY SEALED ENVELOPE FROM EACH ISSUING HIGH SCHOOL
- * MUST TAKE A MATH PLACEMENT TEST AT CHEMEKETA COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND PLACE INTO MATH 70 OR HIGHER.

EMPLOYERS MAY REQUIRE- VALID EMPLOYMENT CRITERIA AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. DRIVER'S LICENSE
2. INSURABILITY TO OPERATE COMPANY VEHICLES
3. DRUG TEST
4. ABILITY TO IDENTIFY THE CONDUCTORS OF A SAMPLE CABLE
5. ABILITY TO FREQUENTLY LIFT AND/OR MOVE 50 POUNDS, SUCH AS TOOL BOXES
6. ABILITY TO OCCASIONALLY LIFT AND/OR MOVE UP TO 90 POUNDS, SUCH AS BAGS OF CONCRETE MIX

HOW DO YOU GET IN?

1. YOU CAN ONLY APPLY DURING AN OPENING (*OPENINGS ARE POSTED AT WWW.IECOREGON.ORG*)
2. ALL ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE SUBMITTED DURING A SCHEDULED OPENING
3. APPLICANTS MUST MEET MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION (*SEE FRONT SIDE*)
4. APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED AND SCORED BASED ON THE APPLICANT'S DOCUMENTATION
5. THE COMMITTEE WILL SELECT APPRENTICES FROM A RANKED POOL OF ELIGIBLES. POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR: EDUCATION, WORK EXPERIENCE AND MILITARY, PEACE CORP VISTA SERVICE.
6. APPLICANTS WILL BE NOTIFIED BY MAIL OF THEIR PLACEMENT AFTER THE COMMITTEE HAS MET AND APPROVED THE POOL .
