**SCHOLARSHIP REMINDER – for 2011 SCHOOL YEAR**

**Four (4)** scholarships in the amount of \$500 have been created to support apprentices as they move through apprenticeship and toward a career in the electrical trade. It will be applied toward their academic expenses.

**MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP** –Apprentice must confirm that they are working for a IEC contractor member before applying for this scholarship. They must be in good standing in their apprenticeship program.

**FINANCIAL HARDSHIP SCHOLARSHIP** -You are encouraged to apply whether you are on the out of work list or currently working. You must be in good standing in the Area II program to apply.

**DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS:**(Pages 3 & 4) are to be received at the IEC Oregon office no later than **Monday, November 21, 2011**. Scholarships will be awarded on **Friday, December 9, 2011**.
